Walter Boechat is part of the project for the Brazilian edition of C.G. Jung's books: *The Red Book* and *The Black Books*, by Vozes Publishing House, and the revisor of the translation of both books from the German original. He is also the technical coordinator of the Jungian series at Vozes. He has published several Books in Brazil and abroad, including: *The Mythopoesis of the Psyche*, Vozes, 2020 3rd reprint., *The Red Book of C. G. Jung: Journey into Unknown Depths*, with a Foreword by Sonu Shamdasani, Vozes, 2014, (with translations into English by Routledge, London, 2017, and into Spanish, by Letra Viva, Buenos Aires.) Walter Boechat has coordinated Research Groups on Jung's Black Books since 2021.
